Monthly Review areas of improvements:

Student groups transcend college borders and organization boundaries. The SUA body can better strive to "ensure continuous and constructive relationships with UCSC student Organizations."
- All questions called before the Assembly should be voted on with a 'Yes" or "No" vote. Abstentions should be used in situations where a conflict of interest arises or if a member believes there was insufficient information for making a decision. An abstention is a suppressed student voice.
