February review and areas of improvements:

- Many interns forget about the google doc and just fill out the timesheet. I have worked out a system to manage all of my staffs pay now though. I have also started sending out thank you texts for filling out the pay and the number of on time submissions has increased. Still trying to improve the system.

I assumed that everyone knew that whoever is funding the event has final say in the event, but not everyone knew that.
