I. Notable Work

- A. Spent much of the day loading all SUA elections data since 1999 into a CSV file for analysis. Reached the following conclusions:
 1. There is no statistically significant advantage gained from being alphabetically first on the ballot; previous indications that such a link might exist was a result of failure to control for unopposed candidates, who are both first on the ballot and extremely likely to win in their category.
 2. The chance of winning an assembly position increases significantly with each subsequent election cycle a candidate chooses to enter.
- B. Answered a number of communications, primarily regarding upcoming administrative meetings.
- C. Attending the weekly assembly meeting, at which the following items were discussed (among others):
 1. A presentation from the campus sustainability office
 2. The introduction of a resolution supporting continued fiscal dispersion through fund matching
 3. Interviews and deliberations for the Elections Commissioner and Assistant Elections Commissioner positions in this year's student elections
 4. A request for increased funding by the African Student Union
