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I. Notable Work

- A. Answered a significant number of emails from over spring break, mainly regarding meetings in the near future.
- B. Coordinated the scheduling of a gauntlet of meetings in Kerr hall this Friday, including talks with Dean of Undergraduate Education Richard Hughey, Chancellor George Blumenthal, and Incoming Executive Vice Chancellor Marlene Tromp. A significant number of plans and materials will need to be drawn up later in the week to prepare for these.
- C. Filed paperwork with the Bay Tree Bookstore to secure a spot in Quarry Plaza for weekly presidential tabling, which will henceforth take place on Wednesdays between 2:00 PM and 5:00 PM.
- D. Confirmed that the other Officer's schedules were conducive to a prescheduled meeting with Chancellor Blumenthal in early May.
- E. Checked on the status of a number of SOFA funding requests.
- F. Updated various pages on the SUA's Web Content Management System to reflect changes in scheduling (primarily as a result of changing office hours).
