

# Student Union Assembly Monthly Report

This monthly evaluation of July 2018 will report the initiatives I am taking on as SUA Vice President of Student Life and constructive criticism in areas of improvement within the SUA. In the following are the projects, meetings, tasks, constructive criticisms and improvements of this month.

# **COMPLETED TASKS**

#### June 27th: 2018 Fall Concert Survey

-Two week long survey conducted to receive information about a concert in the fall and to ask the student body about using SUA funds for a concert

# June 27th: Meeting with Jose Reyes-Olivas for Fall Concert

- -Discussed pricing, budget, and artist
- -Started rough budget

# **July 1st: First Officer Meeting**

-Discussed logistics between officers for rest of year

#### July 6th: First Raffle Up Friday

-Raffled out \$50 to one student that has completed the 2018 Fall Concert Survey

## July 6th: Pantry Set-Up Meeting

- -Spoke to previous pantry manager about set-up and logistics for pantry next year
- -Decided on opening day for pantry this fall (Tentative Day: October 8th)
- -Scheduled Training and Hiring Days for the Month of August and September before school starts to ensure pantry will be opened on time

#### July 7th: Outreach Materials and Officer Tabling Scheduling

- -Prepared PDF flyers for all offices for outreach and engagement during Orientation, OPERS Fest, and SUA Open House
- -Organized Officer Schedules for tabling for orientation

# July 12th: 2018 Fall Concert Survey Closed

-2,507 Responses Received (65% of amount of voters from 2018 SUA Elections- 3,846 votes)

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- -95.4% of students said they likely go to a concert on campus
- -93.6% of students said they agree with using SUA funds for a free fall concert
- -96.6% of students said they agree with a fall concert being used to support basic needs
- -the highest genre voted for is Rap
- -the highest voted artists to perform at the concert is Bryson Tiller, Amine, and E-40

# July 13th: Selected First Raffle Up Friday Winner

-Filip Haltmayer was selected as Winner for 7/6 Raffle Up Friday

# July 15th: 2nd Raffle Up Friday

-Raffled out \$50 to one student that Liked FB Page for Student Life and Commented an event they want to see this year

# **July 21st: Funding Request for Concert to SUA Officers**

- -Concert is worth about \$60,000
- -Request was made for \$20,000 (\$15,000 from carry forward from last year's budget and \$5,000 from regular programming)
- -President made an executive decision that there must be % Officers that must approve in order to approve budget
- -Vote ended with 4/6 Officers approving budget
- -Request Denied
- -Suggestion made by President that \$10,000 should be pulled from programming and additional \$1,500 from each individual Officer's programming line item
- -Vote ended with % Officers approving budget
- -Request Denied
- -Request was tabled for next Officer Meeting on 7/29

#### July 23rd: Check-in Meeting with Jose Reves-Olivas for Fall Concert

- -Discussed further details for budget and artist
- -Discussed meeting times for August and other event details

# **July 26th: SUA Pantry Couches Moved**

- -OPERS complained of people sleeping on SUA Pantry couches
- -Couches were taken to surplus and also replaced older couches in SUA Office

# **July 27th: Transfer Orientation Tabling**

- -Tabled at transfer orientation to spread awareness about SUA
- -Collected emails for interest list

- -Tabled at freshman orientation to spread awareness about SUA
