Fall Quarter review areas of improvements:

- The SUA body has again seen a high turnover rate of representatives this quarter. It is highly evident that representatives are not providing informative and reasonable reports to their constituents, nor making efforts to listen to their constituents.
- A greater amount of cohesive and effective interaction within the Assembly and the campus is needed. It is my hope that future SUA interaction with student organizations begins with those organizations that have voting rights in the SUA.
- To once again reiterate previous sentiments, SUA voting members should consider the voices of their respective constituents, and not only rely on their own personal views when discussing and voting on agenda items. Representatives should be ready for dialogue and discussion at each weekly meeting with their constituent's voices in mind.
- It is the intent of the organization to see increased SUA Officer interaction among each other and with student organizations. It has been evident that communication has been lax. In addition, the SUA should make efforts to further publicize and make transparent any and all funding calls when SUA can and may provide funding to campus student organizations.
